



GDPR 2025 - 2026

At RD Homeschool Ltd, we are committed to ensuring compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and protecting the privacy rights of our clients. This GDPR Policy outlines our practices for collecting, processing, and storing personal data in accordance with GDPR requirements.

1. Lawful Basis for Data Processing:

We only collect and process personal data when there is a lawful basis for doing so under GDPR. This includes obtaining explicit consent from individuals for specific purposes, fulfilling contractual obligations, complying with legal obligations, or pursuing legitimate interests where they do not override individuals' rights and freedoms.

2. Data Collection and Purpose Limitation:

We collect personal data from clients only for specified, explicit, and legitimate purposes related to the provision of our tutoring services. We do not process personal data in a manner incompatible with these purposes or retain it for longer than necessary to fulfil the intended purposes.

3. Data Minimisation and Accuracy:

We strive to collect only the minimum amount of personal data necessary for achieving the specified purposes. We take reasonable steps to ensure the accuracy and currency of personal data and promptly update or delete inaccurate or outdated information when notified.

4. Data Security and Confidentiality:

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data against unauthorised access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction. This includes encryption, access controls, regular security assessments, and staff training on data protection best practices.

5. Data Transfers:

We do not transfer personal data outside the European Economic Area (EEA) unless adequate safeguards are in place to ensure an equivalent level of protection for the data, as required by GDPR.

6. Data Subject Rights:

We respect individuals' rights under GDPR, including the right to access, rectify, erase, restrict processing, and object to the processing of their personal data. We provide mechanisms for individuals to exercise these rights and respond to requests in a timely manner.

7. Data Breach Notification:

In the event of a personal data breach, we have procedures in place to promptly assess the risk to individuals' rights and freedoms and notify the relevant supervisory authority and affected individuals as required by GDPR.

8. Data Protection Impact Assessments (DPIAs):

We conduct DPIAs for high-risk data processing activities to assess and mitigate potential risks to individuals' privacy rights. We involve relevant stakeholders, including data protection officers and individuals, in the DPIA process.

9. Data Protection Officer (DPO):



We have appointed a Data Protection Officer responsible for overseeing GDPR compliance, providing advice and guidance on data protection matters, and serving as a point of contact for supervisory authorities and data subjects.

10. Compliance Monitoring and Review:

We regularly review and update our GDPR compliance efforts to ensure alignment with evolving legal requirements and industry standards. This includes conducting internal audits, staff training, and engaging with regulatory authorities as necessary.
